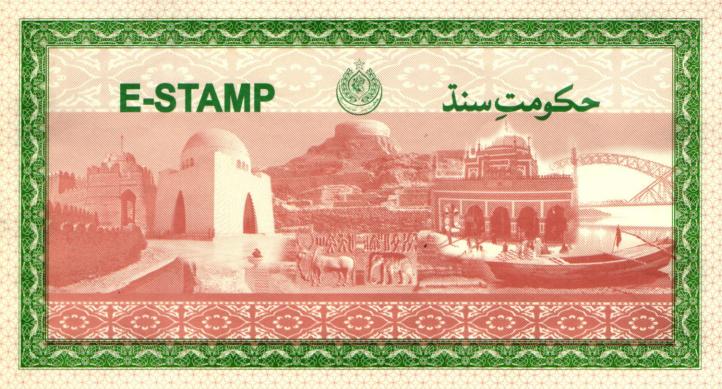

Vendor agrees to provide the services to the Bank as per tender opening date 11-10-2022.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

The Vendor shall establish data connectivity between the branches of the Purchaser and its Head Office or any given site/location through L3 VPNs over the Vendor's MPLS based network, by installing and commissioning of Links at the sites specified hereinabove ('Sites').

- 1. All terms and conditions of the tender document will remain part of this Agreement.
- 2. All 35 Links must be installed and handed over within 30 days after the order of installation in Pakistan. The Purchaser shall impose a fine of Rs. 500/- per day in case of failure to deploy the Links at the Un-Installed Sites within 5 days of the Delivery Timelines with respect to such Sites and Rs, 1000/- per day will be charged in case of failure of deploy the Links at the un-installed Sites within 15 days of the Delivery Timelines up to maximum of Rs100,000/- per branch. Vendor will be issued a certificate of delivery /satisfaction by the Purchaser which shall evidence that data connectivity at un-installed sites has been established with other sites.

- 7. Subject to Clause 4, the Monthly Recurring Charges shall be payable on a quarterly basis. 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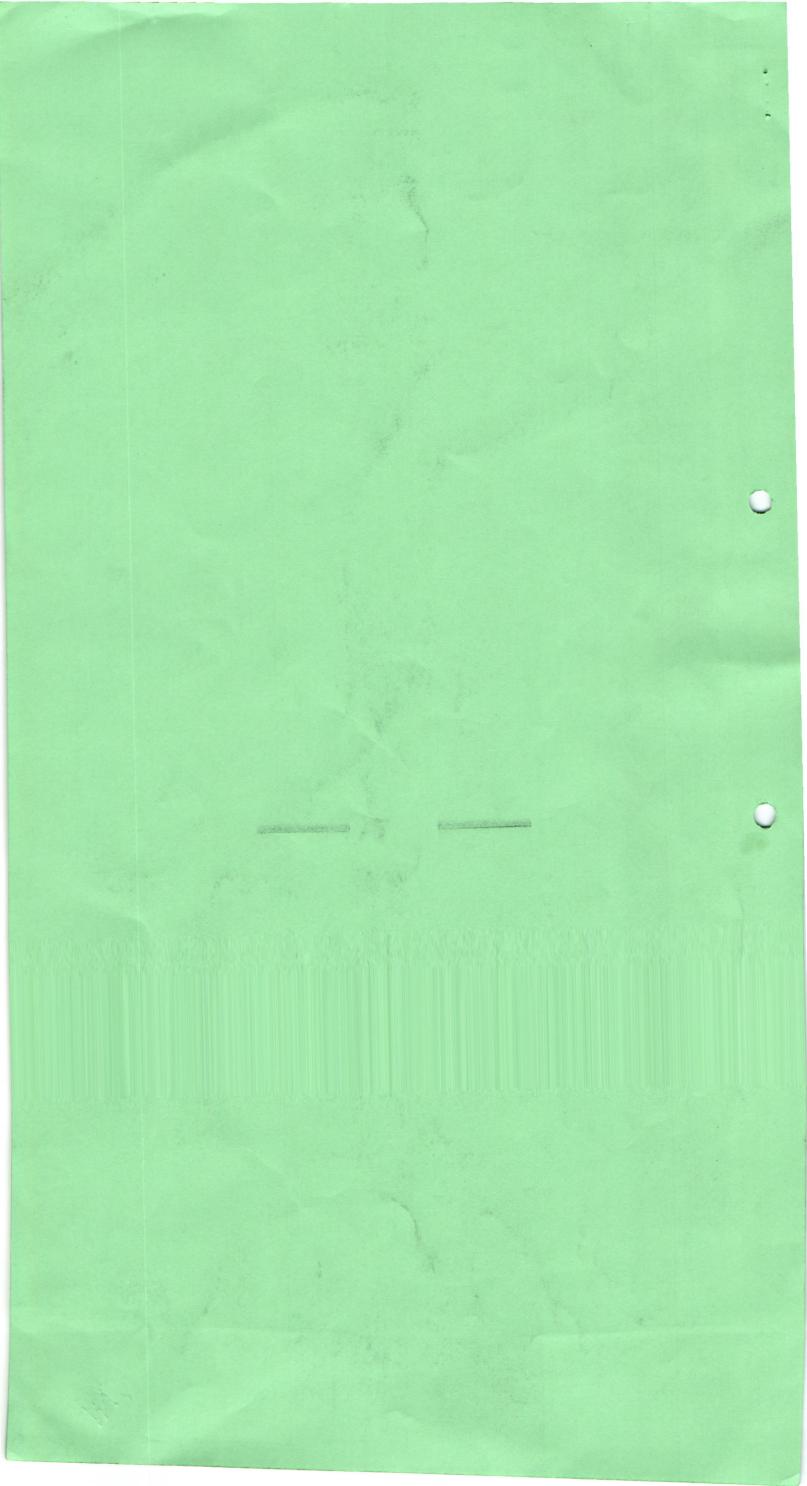
